

Lisa Schisel Huinker graduated from Garner-Hayfield in 1981. In 1977, Lisa won a Junior Pentathlon in Ankeny. While in high school, she participated in basketball, track and softball. Lisa qualified for the state track meet all four years of high school. In 1978, she qualified for two events at Drake Relays, the 100 meter dash and the 4x100 relay. In 1989, Lisa was inducted into the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union Track and Field Hall of Fame. Over the course of her career, Lisa has earned more than 115 first place finishes in track. She has five state titles: 1978: 4x200 relay, 1980: 100m hurdles, 1981: Shuttle Hurdle, 200m and 100m hurdles. Her winning time in the 100m hurdles was the fastest time overall at the state meet. When Lisa finished high school, she was the school record holder in nine events: 100m, 200m, 400m, 100m hurdles, 400m hurdles, long jump, 4x100, 4x200 and shuttle hurdle. As of 2021, she is the record holder in ten events. Lisa was a ten time North Iowa Conference Track and Field Champion. Throughout her high school career, she competed in fourteen events at the state meet, placing in eleven events.

In 1981 she was selected 1st Team All State in softball. In her softball career, she scored 117 runs and stole 127 bases. She was a North Iowa all conference player four years (two times on 2nd Team and two times on 1st Team). In 1981, she was first team All State for softball. After high school, Lisa went to college at Iowa Central Community College in Fort Dodge, Iowa and played softball. She graduated in 1982 with a one year secretarial certificate.
